

Installation instructions and tips for Royal Rascals® Baby Car Mirror



Thank you for purchasing our Royal Rascals® Baby Car Mirror, we think you've made a great choice!

Below are some important tips to help install your Royal Rascals® Baby Car Mirror perfectly. There are two options below, Option 1 being the most common.

OPTION 1:

- 1. Remove the Royal Rascals® Baby Car Mirror from the box.
 - **Tip 1:** Leave the protective film on the mirror until after you have installed it. This will help reduce finger marks from day one and keep the reflection crystal clear.
 - **Tip 2:** Ensure that both buckles are unclipped before attempting to install.
- 2. Clip one strap around the headrest and tighten until secure.
- **3.** Repeat with the second strap as per Step 2.
- **4.** Double check that both straps are tightened sufficiently.
 - **Tip 1:** Do not overly tighten just enough so that the mirror is securely held in place.
 - **Tip 2:** Check that both straps are not twisted.
 - **Tip 3:** Buckles are best located near the centre of the headrest and not on the edge see image below.



- **5.** Once your Royal Rascals® Baby Car Mirror is securely fastened, test the mirror's angle by turning and tilting it until it is positioned so you can see your baby when in the driving seat. Note: You may need to test this a couple of times until you get the right angle and also if you accidentally knock the mirror out of position when placing your child in the car seat.
- **6.** Enjoy seeing your baby whilst driving and knowing they are safe with your new Royal Rascals® Baby Car Mirror.

OPTION 2:

Follow the instructions identically to **Option 1** but place the straps diagonally around the headrest. Depending on the shape of your car's headrest you may find this works better for you. See image below.



Tip: Do not place buckles on the edge of the head rest – try to place them in the centre.

Baby on Board Sign – the recommended location for the Baby on Board sign is ideally behind the backseat headrest on the driver's side. This way it isn't obscuring your view and is directly in the line-of-sight of the motorist behind you.
